Deadline: Before 15 January 2025

Its purpose is to foster member participation in the creation of knowledge, and knowledge transfer and exchange within the intersection of psychoanalysis and sexual and gender diversity.

- Original Papers may be submitted in English, French, German or Spanish
- 8000 to 10000 words
- Members, Analysts in training or nonmembers





Tiresias Award

Purpose: This award was created by the Sexual and Gender Diversity Studies Committee (S&GDSco) and awarded for the first time in 2021. Its purpose is to foster member participation in the creation of knowledge, and knowledge transfer and exchange within the intersection of psychoanalysis and sexual and gender diversity. The S&GDSco hopes these priorities will help as directives to be addressed in the competing papers.

Understanding dilemmas of pathology and health as they play out in the realm of gender when working with sexual and gender diverse patients.

An intersectional approach that considers racial and ethnic diversity within sexual and gender diverse patients.

Revision of classic papers and proposals of fresh, original conceptualizations of understanding the enigmaolence towards sexual and gender diverse patients (inside and outside the clinical situation).

Award: The award will comprise US\$1000 to the winner paper and the opportunity to present the winning paper, depending on space availability at the Congress.





Eligibility

By papers sent in response to the call for entries by Members, Analysts in training or non-members.

Papers may be submitted in English, French, German or Spanish.

Original and previously unpublished manuscript, in English.

8000 to 10000 words, double spaced, 12 pt font APA Style reference.

Addresses at least one of the four priorities of the award.

If clinical material is presented, it must have patient consent, be disguised and/or presented in a composite manner for confidentiality purposes.

Selection: The winner of the award will be selected by the The Sexual and Gender Diversity Studies Committee (S&GDSco) Paper submissions will be scored by a judging panel that will include members of the S&GDSco and guests.

Announcement and Presentation: The award will be made at the IPA congress and presented by the S&GDSco Chair.
